Restoring Eagle Lake's only Native Trout



Trout Unlimited and the California Department of Fish and Wildlife are partnering up to restore and expand wild, self-sustaining Eagle Lake rainbow trout in the Eagle Lake Basin. There have been a lot of significant steps made over the past decade to rebuild strong, resilient populations of these fish, and here is your chance to be a part of it all!

These are four-day trips to the Pine Creek headwaters to remove non-native Brook trout that compete with native Eagle Lake rainbow trout. It is a great opportunity to learn more about Trout Unlimited and our lead State fish agency, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife. Our Basecamp will be Bogard Campground, and camping/cooking equipment can be provided if necessary. Don't miss out on this amazing opportunity!
